Student Tours/Youth Tours at Ashfall Fossil Beds State Historical Park

Thank you for your interest in student programs at the Ashfall Fossil Beds. A visit to Ashfall is an unusual educational experience. Students view a real fossil site that has been referred to as “one of the wonders of the natural world”. A tour leader provides an orientation and full description of the fossil bed exposed in the Hubbard Rhino Barn.

Youth tours/student tours can be scheduled mid-April through mid-October.

Guided Tours are offered Tuesday through Friday.

Tours are offered at 9:30 am, 11:00 am, and 1:00 pm.

Cost is \$5.00 per person (youngsters, students and parent supervisors). There is a minimum fee of \$60. for small groups with 12 or fewer participants. This rate applies to the spring and autumn field trip season.

Teachers are complimentary.

Tour lasts approximately one hour.

Allow an additional 15–20 minutes for the stay.

Maximum group size is 45 per tour. Larger groups need to reserve two separate tour times.

Reservations are required and must be made via telephone during regular business hours. **(402) 893-2000**.

Have an alternate date and time available when making reservations as scheduling is on a first call basis and only one group can be accommodated at a time.
